

## **Guidelines for all Students in case of SARS-CoV-2 infection or COVID-19 disease in a person at the WSA or NSP community**

1. Allowed on the premises are persons:
  - healthy,
  - not quarantined or in isolation
  - who within the last 10 days did not have a conscious and direct contact with persons diagnosed with COVID-19, this does not apply to the fully vaccinated and the convalescent\*, unless the Rector or a person acting on their behalf decides otherwise.
2. Persons that have symptoms of COVID-19 are prohibited from the School's premises.
3. Persons that have symptoms of COVID-19 or suspect being infected with the coronavirus should stay at home and seek a remote consultation or a doctor's appointment with a primary care physician.
4. A person with a COVID-19 test referral, with a COVID-19 diagnosis (a positive test result), the isolated or quarantined should immediately inform the School about this fact. Telephone contact with the Studies Organization Office (BOS) and official information via e-mail at [wsa@wsa.art.pl](mailto:wsa@wsa.art.pl) or [bos@wsa.art.pl](mailto:bos@wsa.art.pl).
5. Any student who has received information about their positive COVID-19 test result is obliged to disclose the dates of his latest presence at the WSA Warszawa premises and to report groups of people they directly contacted.
6. The School's employee will list everyone who might have had a direct contact with the infected person, basing on the paper register of entry and/or the electronic system of entry registering, statement of whereabouts for each entry, group lists and/ or attendance lists for didactic classes.
7. Persons who had a direct contact with a SARS-COV-2 infected individual will be immediately informed about a COVID-19 case at the School's premises.
8. Persons infected with coronavirus or those who directly contacted the infected person are obliged to follow the latest guidance from the Główny Inspektorat Sanitarny (Chief Sanitary Inspectorat).

9. Person infected with the coronavirus cannot take part in the didactic classes at the School's premises until the end of isolation period. Such person may take part in remote classes, organized with the use of remote teaching methods and techniques.
10. Persons who had contact with the coronavirus infected (e.g. particular persons, a group, a cohort, a teacher, an administrative worker) are directed to a remote mode of work/ study by the School for the period of 10 days since the day following the last direct contact with the coronavirus infected, if the nature of the work/ classes allows for it or delays them to the next possible date, but no earlier than after 10 days since the day following the last direct contact with the coronavirus infected.
11. Substitutions, schedule changes and changes in classes' due dates will be determined in accordance with the current guidelines connected to the epidemic situation and valid guidelines for the School.

12. Classrooms in which the coronavirus infected has been present will be sanitized with all safety precautions.
13. The School Coordinator will report aggregated numerical data on the cases of the COVID-19, isolation and quarantine submitted at the School to National KRASP Coordinator.

**\*A fully vaccinated person**, is a person, who has received a confirmation of vaccination against COVID-19 approved in the EU. Full vaccination is valid after 14 days of completing the vaccination process.

**\*Convalescent**, is a person, who has completed their hospitalisation or isolation in domestic environment as a consequence of their confirmed coronavirus infection within the last 6 months.
